

## INSTRUCTION AND LEARNING COMMITTEE

### CHARGE:

The Committee on Instruction and Learning shall be charged with the responsibility for encouraging and fostering development of continuous assessment and improvement of instruction and recognition of its primacy in all Speed Scientific School programs. In achievement of these purposes, this committee is expected to establish and maintain constant awareness, develop policies of evaluation, and disseminate information concerned with or relative to the improvement of teaching and special programs directed toward skills and unique teaching problems faced by potential and experienced Speed Scientific School faculty. In addition, this committee shall be responsible for coordination with committees of similar nature among other academic units in the University.

The Committee will elect one Faculty member and one student member to serve as the representative from the Speed Scientific School on the University Senate Committee for Improving Instruction and Learning.

The Committee shall make a written report to the Faculty of its activities annually. These annual reports should be submitted to the president of the Faculty Council before July 1, of each year.

### COMPOSITION:

Six voting members. Three shall be faculty and three shall be students.

### SELECTION:

Faculty members are elected by the Faculty and student members are selected in accordance with procedures established by the Student Council.

Faculty terms are two years staggered terms. The term of the student member is one year. The term of new members shall begin on July 1.
