

## STANDARDS AND ADMISSIONS COMMITTEE

### CHARGE:

The Speed Scientific School Standards and Admissions Committee is given the responsibility to recommend admission requirements to academic programs in the Speed Scientific School at all levels and shall regularly review the criteria for admission and continuance in these programs. In addition, this Committee will specifically review and recommend to the Office of the Dean standards and procedures on academic performance as they affect student participation in extracurricular activities, academic probation, withdrawal, and /or dismissal from the Speed Scientific School because of unsatisfactory academic attainment.

When requested to do so by the Office of the Dean, the Committee will also review and make recommendations on questionable applications for admission, petitions for readmission from students previously dismissed, or appeals in other academic matters as they relate to admissions or academic performance standards. Possible modifications of existing grading systems, e.g., standardization of "I" grades, pass-fail option, etc., shall be referred to this Committee.

The committee, at the discretion of its membership, may invite representation from the Office of Admissions, University Testing Service, or knowledgeable others when appropriate.

The committee shall make a written report to the Faculty of its activities annually. These annual reports should be submitted to the President of the Faculty Council before July 1, of each year.

### COMPOSITION:

The committee shall consist of six Faculty members, one of whom is the Associate Dean for Academic Services, and a 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> year student, designated by the President of the Student Council.

### SELECTION:

Faculty members shall be appointed by the Faculty Council.

### TERMS:

Faculty terms are two staggered terms. The term of the student member is one year. The term of new members shall begin on July 1.
