Application Materials

All application materials should be submitted to graduate school admissions.

- A Graduate School applications (see www.louisville.edu)
- A non-refundable \$50 application fee.
- Two letters of reference from individuals knowledgeable about the applicant's qualifications, abilities, and potential for a successful career in environmental health. (can be submitted with form at <http://graduate.louisville.edu/app/grad-rec.pdf>)
- Official, original academic records from each institution attended beyond secondary level. Transcript should reflect degree awarded.
- Resume or curriculum vitae.
- A personal statement describing the applicant's qualifications, including prior experience, proposed (general) area of research, and career plans.
- GRE exam score.
- If applicable, TOEFL scores.
- If applicable, foreign credential evaluation

Application Submission Deadlines

Applications are accepted for fall and spring semesters. For the fall semester applications are due by May 1st and for spring semester applications are due by November 1 each year.
