## Application Materials

**All application materials should be submit to graduate school admissions.**

- A Graduate School application. (see [www.graduate/louisville.edu](http://www.graduate/louisville.edu) )
- A non-refundable \$50 application fee.
- Two letters of reference from individuals knowledgeable about the applicant's qualifications, abilities, and potential for a successful career in environmental health. (can be submitted with form at <http://graduate.louisville.edu/app/grad-rec.pdf>)
- Official, original academic records from each institution attended beyond secondary level. Transcript should reflect degree awarded.
- Resume or curriculum vitae.
- A personal statement describing the applicant's qualifications, including prior experience, proposed (general) area of research, and career plans.
- GRE exam score.
- If applicable, TOEFL scores.
- If applicable, foreign credential evaluation

## Application Submission Deadlines

Applications are accepted for fall semesters only. For the fall semester applications are due by May 1<sup>st</sup>.
