¹ Senate meetings are held in the afternoon on the 2nd Monday of each month. Attendance at every meeting is encouraged and expected. University of Louisville Staff Senate by-laws allow for only four (4) absences from regular monthly meetings during a fiscal year (July 1 to June 30). After five (5) absences the seat shall be deemed vacant and a call for nominations made to elect a new senator.

² Each senator is appointed to one of the Staff Senate's standing committees which meet on average once a month. In addition, senators may be appointed to represent the Staff Senate by serving on a university-wide committee. Meeting schedules for these committees vary, but also usually meet once a month.

³ Periodically, there are senate vacancies representing work-units throughout the university, for which no nominations for election are received. These seats are declared at-large, and the staff senate elects nominees from the at-large ballot to represent these work-units. At-large applications are retained in the senate office for the remainder of the fiscal year.
