What is Ultra Metroversity?

Metroversity is a program that allows JCTC students to take a class at UofL and pay the JCTC cost while experiencing a University classroom setting. Ultra students have an **easier** pathway to register for Metroversity classes. **Some classes in Nursing, Education, Engineering, Music and Upper Division Business may have additional requirements** – your ULtra advisor will check on this. Metroversity students also receive a UofL student ID and a Parking Pass at no extra cost. This is an excellent way to begin the transition to UofL or to take classes not available at JCTC.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Have completed at least 12 transferable credit hours **at the time of registration.**
2. Have an established GPA of at least a **2.0 at the time of registration for 100 or 200 level courses. A 3.0 is required for all courses at the 300 level and above.**
3. Must be an ULtra student. See below.

Steps to take prior to Registration:

1. Sign up to become an ULtra student (if not already). Do this by meeting with an advisor in the office by July 21.
2. Check with an ULtra advisor before registration opens to verify your eligibility for Metroversity.
3. Find class/classes that fit your degree plan and schedule. Go to hal.louisville.edu to review the UofL fall 2011 schedule of classes. Make note of the course name, catalog and class number for when you come to register.

***Classes at U of L will not start till August 22 but the last date to drop, change or add will be August 17 in accordance with your home campus, JCTC , policies**

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If you miss the ULtra Registration Dates:

Students who miss the November 22nd cutoff date for ULtra Metroversity Registration must obtain the required signatures and complete the registration process on their own at the UofL Registrar's office by **January 11th**. See the Metroversity website for contact and information

After Registering for your UofL Class

1. Activate your Ulink, email, Blackboard and PeopleSoft accounts at <http://louisville.edu/admissions/activate>. If you need technical assistance with passwords, email, etc... contact the Helpdesk at 852-7997
2. Class schedule, location, time, etc... will be available on your UofL Ulink account. Check this and your UofL email regularly for course information.
3. Pick up parking pass and UofL Student ID card-- Your Purple Permit is valid for the Papa John Stadium lot before 5:00pm. Shuttles run to the campus every 3 to 5 minutes. After 5:00 pm you can park in red, blue or green lots. Never park in a yellow spot! Parking passes will be distributed **January 9th-13th** in the Transfer Center, Ultra @ Belknap office, lower level of the Houchens building. Student ID cards can be made in the Cardinal Card office, also located on the lower level of the Houchens Building Room 08K .

To Drop a Metroversity Class:

You must contact ULtra Advisor Tawana McWhorter from your KCTCS email at ultra@louisville.edu and let her know you want to drop. **This is the only way to drop your Metroversity course by the stated deadlines.**

CAUTIONS: Please Read

- Some UofL courses generate a fee ranging from \$10 to \$50. Labs, HSS courses, and studio art classes usually have fees associated. Check your Ulink account to see if you have a UofL fee and pay in the Bursars office in the Houchens Building on UofL's campus.
- **Books required for UofL courses are not generally available in the JCTC bookstore. The financial aid waiver for the JCTC bookstore cannot be used at the UofL bookstore.**
- If you miss the ULtra deadline, and/or have to add Metroversity courses January 11th, your financial aid will not cover the tuition. Make sure you are registered full time at JCTC in order to maintain that status, then if you get into a class at UofL, drop one of your JCTC courses. This will keep you as a fulltime student for census and financial aid purposes at JCTC.
- JCTC and UofL have different policies regarding dropping classes. UofL does not allow students to drop a class through the end of the semester. The only way you can drop a UofL Metroversity class is through your ULtra advisor –in accordance with JCTC policy, not UofL.
