
Annual Minx Auerbach Lecture in Women's & Gender Studies



Michael Kimmel is one of the world's leading experts on men and masculinities. Among his many books are *Manhood in America*; *Angry White Men*; *The Politics of Manhood*; *The Gendered Society*; and the bestseller *Guyland: The Perilous World Where Boys Become Men*. With funding from the MacArthur Foundation, he founded the Center for the Study of Men and Masculinities at Stony Brook University in 2013.

A tireless advocate of engaging men to support gender equality, Kimmel has delivered the International Women's Day annual lecture at the European Parliament, the European Commission, and the Council of Europe, and has worked with the Ministers for Gender Equality of Norway, Denmark, and Sweden. He has lectured at more than 300 colleges, universities, and high schools, and consults widely with corporations, NGOs, and public sector organizations on gender equity issues. Kimmel was recently named "the world's most prominent male feminist" by *The Guardian* newspaper in London.
