In Latin 303 the student will continue to learn principles of Latin grammar and to compose Latin sentences that express correct Latin grammar and idiomatic expression. Class objectives will be accomplished through a combination of Latin translation, grammatical analysis, and composition. The objectives are as follows:

- 1) to learn fundamentals of Latin grammar;
- 2) to compose text that reflects correct grammar and idiom;
- 3) to strengthen English grammar and composition skill through interaction with Latin text
