9		→ S	ection 1. KRS 164.821 is amended to read as follows:
10	(1)	The	government of the University of Louisville is vested in a board of trustees
11		appo	pinted for a term set by law pursuant to Section 23 of the Constitution of
12		Ken	tucky. The board shall consist of ten (10) [seventeen (17)] members appointed
13		by the	ne Governor, at least one (1) of whom shall be a graduate of the university;
14		one	(1) member of the teaching faculty of the University of Louisville who shall be
15	the chief executive of the ranking unit of faculty government; one (1)[a] member of		
16	the permanent staff of the University of Louisville who shall be the chief executive		
17		of th	ne staff senate; and <u>one (1)[a]</u> student member who shall be the president of the
18	student body during the appropriate academic year. The members appointed by the		
19		Gov	ernor shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate.
20		(a)	All appointed and elected persons shall be required to attend and complete an
21			orientation and education program prescribed by the council under KRS
22			164.020(25), as a condition of their service and eligibility for appointment or
23			election to a second term.
24		(b)	Board members may be removed by the Governor for cause, which shall
25			include neglect of duty or malfeasance in office, after being afforded a hearing
26			with counsel before the Council on Postsecondary Education and a finding of
27			fact by the council.
