3	WHEREAS, effective	governance of public postsecondary institutions is critical to
4	the thousands of Kentucky 1	postsecondary students and to Kentucky's economy; and
5	5 WHEREAS, the Ger	neral Assembly finds that a fresh start is required for the
6	6 continued effective governa	nce of the University of Louisville;
7	7 NOW, THEREFORE	
8	8 Be it enacted by the Genero	al Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
9	Section 1. KRS 16	54.821 is amended to read as follows:
10	0 (1) The government of t	he University of Louisville is vested in a board of trustees
11	1 appointed for a term	set by law pursuant to Section 23 of the Constitution of
12	2 Kentucky. The board	shall consist of ten (10)[seventeen (17)] members appointed
13	by the Governor, at l	east one (1) of whom shall be a graduate of the university;
14	one (1) member of the	e teaching faculty of the University of Louisville who shall be
15	5 the chief executive of	the ranking unit of faculty government; one (1)[a] member of
16	the permanent staff of	the University of Louisville who shall be the chief executive
17	of the staff senate; and	d one (1)[a] student member who shall be the president of the
18	student body during the	ne appropriate academic year. The members appointed by the
19	Governor shall be sul	pject to confirmation by the Senate.
20	(a) All appointed ar	nd elected persons shall be required to attend and complete an
21	1 orientation and	education program prescribed by the council under KRS
22	2 164.020(25), as	a condition of their service and eligibility for appointment or
23	election to a sec-	ond term.
24	4 (b) Board members	may be removed by the Governor for cause, which shall
25	5 include neglect	of duty or malfeasance in office, after being afforded a hearing
26	6 with counsel be	fore the Council on Postsecondary Education and a finding of
27	7 fact by the coun	eil.

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1		(c)	New appointees to the board shall not serve more than two (2) consecutive
2			terms. [Board members serving as of May 30, 1997, may be reappointed at the
3			end of their existing terms and may serve two (2) additional full consecutive
4			terms.]
5	(2)	<u>The</u>	student member shall serve a one (1) year term that shall begin upon being
6		<u>elect</u>	ted and sworn in as student body president. If the student member does not
7		mair	ntain \underline{the} [his] position \underline{of} [as] student body president or \underline{the} [his] status \underline{of} [as] a
8		full-	time student at any time during that academic year, a special election shall be
9		held	to select a full-time student member. The $\underline{\textit{elected}}$ student member shall serve
10		for <u>t</u>	he remainder of the unexpired term [a term of one (1) year beginning with the
11		first	meeting of the fiscal year which contains that academic year].
12	(3)	The	faculty member $\underline{and}_{[,]}$ staff member $[, and student body member]$ shall \underline{serve}
13		one	(1) year terms and cease to be eligible for membership on the board of trustees
14		upor	n termination of their respective relationships with, or leadership positions
15		<u>with</u>	<u>in</u> , the university, and vacancies occurring for this reason shall be filled for the
16		rema	ainder of the respective terms in the same manner. [The voting members of the
17		boar	d shall select a chairperson annually.]
18	(4)	The	gubernatorial appointments shall serve a term of six (6) years and until their
19		succ	essors are appointed and qualified, except the initial terms shall be as follows:
20		(a)	Two (2) members shall serve one (1) year terms;
21		(b)	<u>Two (2)</u> [Three (3)] members shall serve two (2) year terms;
22		(c)	<u>Two (2)</u> [Three (3)] members shall serve three (3) year terms[, one (1) of
23			whom shall be a graduate of the university, selected from a list of three (3)
24			names submitted by the alumni of the university in the manner and according
25			to rules prescribed by the board of trustees];
26		(d)	<u>Two (2)</u> [Three (3)] members shall serve four (4) year terms;
27		(e)	One (1) member[Three (3) members] shall serve <u>a</u> five (5) year <u>term</u> [terms];

2		(f) <u>One (1) member</u> [Three (3) members] shall serve \underline{a} six (6) year \underline{term} [terms,
3		one (1) of whom shall be a graduate of the university, selected as under
4		paragraph (c) of this subsection].
5	(5)	The Governor shall make his at-large appointments so as to divide the
6		<u>appointed</u> [citizen] representation upon the board to reflect:
7		(a) The proportional representation of the two (2) leading political parties in the
8		Commonwealth based on the state's voter registration; and
9	<u>(b)</u>	[shall reflect]No less than <u>the</u> proportional representation of the minority racial
10		composition of the Commonwealth <u>based on the total minority racial population</u>
11		using the most recent census or estimate data from the United States Census
12		Bureau. If the determination of proportional minority representation does not
13		result in a whole number of minority members, it shall be rounded up to the next
14		whole number.[The membership may include one (1) graduate of the institution
15		who resides outside the Commonwealth, but he shall not be reimbursed for out of-
16		state travel.]
17	(6)	Vacancies among the <u>appointed</u> [citizen] members of the board occurring by death,
18		resignation, or any other cause, other than expiration of a term, shall be filled by
19		appointments made by the Governor for the <u>remainder</u> [expiration] of the <u>unexpired</u>
20		term, subject to the qualifications set forth in this section.
21	(7)	Unless specifically approved by the board of trustees under the provisions of KRS
22		164.367, no member of the teaching or administrative staff of the university shall be
23		directly or indirectly interested in any contract with the university for the sale of
24		property, materials, supplies, equipment, or services, with the exception of
25		compensation to the faculty, staff, and student members.
26		→ Section 2. KRS 164.830 is amended to read as follows:
27	(1)	The board of trustees of the University of Louisville shall constitute a body

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corporate, with the usual corporate powers, and shall possess all the authorities, immunities, rights, privileges, and franchises usually attaching to the governing bodies of Kentucky public higher educational institutions. <u>A majority of the voting</u> <u>members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business</u>. Powers of the board shall include the following:

- (a) Appointment of a president, all faculty members, and other personnel and determination of the compensation, duties, and official relations of each. No relative of a board of trustee member shall be employed by the university.
- (b) Suspension or removal of the president, officers, faculty, agents, or other personnel that it is authorized to appoint, except that no president, professor, or teacher shall be removed except for incompetence, neglect of or refusal to perform his duty, or for immoral conduct and that the removal shall be made in accordance with procedures established by law for state institutions.
- (c) Election of a <u>chairperson</u>, a vice chairperson <u>to act in the absence or temporary disability of the chairperson</u>, and any other officers as it deems wise, including the annual election of a six (6) member executive committee which shall have the powers that the board delegates to it and shall operate under the rules the board shall establish under its authority to make bylaws, rules, and regulations consistent with this chapter. The committee shall have one (1) member representing the students, faculty, and nonteaching personnel with the group alternating each year. The initial appointment to the executive committee after <u>the effective date of this Act</u>[May 30, 1997], shall be a faculty member, to be followed by a student and a nonteaching personnel, respectively.
- (d) Receipt, retention, and administration, on behalf of the university, subject to the conditions attached, all revenues accruing from endowments, appropriations, allotments, grants or bequests, and all types of property.

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1		(e)	Requirement of reports from the president, officers, faculty, and employees as
2			it deems necessary and proper from time to time.
3		(f)	Granting degrees to graduates of the university, prescription of conditions
4			upon which postgraduate honors may be obtained, and conferment of
5			honorary degrees.
6		(g)	The board shall periodically evaluate the institution's progress in
7			implementing its missions, goals, and objectives to conform to the strategic
8			agenda. Officers and officials shall be held accountable for the status of the
9			institution's progress.
10	(2)	Boa	rd members shall receive no compensation for serving on the board, but shall
11		<u>be r</u>	eimbursed for travel expenses for attending meetings and performing other
12		<u>offic</u>	cial functions, consistent with the reimbursement policy for state employees.
13		Boa	rd members who reside outside the Commonwealth shall not be reimbursed
14		for a	out-of-state travel expenses.
15	<u>(3)</u>	The	provisions of KRS 164.030, 164.200, and 164.410, shall be applicable to the
16		Univ	versity of Louisville except where inconsistent with the purposes of KRS

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under Section 3 of this Act, all authority, functions, and responsibilities vested in the

former board of trustees of the University of Louisville shall be transferred to the newly

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1 re-created and established board of trustees of the University of Louisville. The board of 2 trustees of the University of Louisville as it existed prior to the ten appointments shall be 3 abolished. All duties, functions, responsibilities, records, equipment, staff, and supporting budgets of the former board of trustees of the University of Louisville and all functions, 4 5 rights, powers, duties, and obligations as set forth in the Kentucky Revised Statutes and 6 other relevant provisions of the law shall be transferred to the newly re-created and 7 established board. 8 \rightarrow Section 6. Whereas the effective governance of public postsecondary 9 institutions is critical to Kentucky's economy, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 10 Act takes effect upon its passage and approval by the Governor or upon its otherwise 11 becoming a law.
