CLINICAL EXPERIENCES

Clinical rotations begin in the spring of junior year, rotating students through different clinical experiences and specialties such as pediatrics or special needs dentistry.

COMMUNITY EXTERNSHIPS

- » Take place over four weeks in senior year, typically in a private practice, working as a hygienist.
- » An opportunity to learn what it is like to be in the field with future colleagues.
- » Placement decided by faculty using their connections in the community.
- » Provides preparation for boards and licensure, which the school helps to facilitate at the end of your college career.
- » Built into the curriculum for the April right before graduation, providing preparation for boards and licensure.

DENTAL HYGIENE (B.S.)

The School of Dentistry provides you with a comprehensive education and will expand your personal and professional growth as a future dental hygienist. The program curriculum serves as a broad-based foundation for the changing complexities of health care, equipping students to provide comprehensive dental hygiene care in a variety of settings.

» Lower Division

Explore general education courses and lay the foundation in natural sciences, social sciences and communications.

» Upper Division

Complete a focused and in-depth program, housed within the School of Dentistry. Admission to the upper division is selective and requires an interview.

Classes and experiences will teach you important skills in a context that emphasize your important place within a dental health team. Our program prepares you for opportunities in:

- » Administration and management
- » Corporate sales
- » Education
- » Patient care, including select populations such as senior citizens, children and special needs patients
- » Public health

With an accreditation from the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association, the School of Dentistry is a leader in computer-assisted education in state-of-the-art classrooms and clinics. Students practice clinical skills on computerized, lifelike patient mannequins in the newly renovated Simulation Clinic.
