Lt Col Jeremy L. Allen is the Commander of Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 295 at the University of Louisville. He is responsible for recruiting, educating, training, and preparing students for commissioning into the United States Air Force as second lieutenants. He also serves as Chairman of the Aerospace Studies Department in the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Louisville.

Prior to assuming his current position, Lieutenant Colonel Allen commanded the 381st Intelligence Squadron at Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson, Alaska and served as the Chief, Analysis Division, Intelligence Directorate, US Air Forces in Europe-Air Forces Africa, Ramstein AB, Germany. Additionally, he was an instructor in the Department of Joint, Interagency, and Multinational Operations at the US Army Command and General Staff College and served as instructor & Assistant Director of Operations at the 19th Weapons Squadron, building, teaching, and leading intelligence surveillance, and



reconnaissance Airman in the Air Force Weapons School. He has also completed operational tours executing signals intelligence, human intelligence, support to special operations forces, and air operations center missions.

Lieutenant Colonel Allen received his commission from Middle Tennessee State University in 2005. He is a graduate of the US Air Force Weapons School with deployments supporting Joint Special Operations Task Force - Philippines and operations Iraqi Freedom, Enduring Freedom, and Tomodachi.
