## Project Description

Callacpuma (~1000B.C.-A.D. 1532) is a large multi-component site with public architecture, households, caves, and rock art. Participants will survey, map and excavate architectural contexts, as well as record the rock art. Students will live in nearby Baños del Inca, a town known for its thermal hot springs, and explore the colonial city of Cajamarca (5km from Baños del Inca).
