Accelerated Anthropology BA/MA

Anthropology continually searches for ways to streamline our students' paths toward timely graduation. For this reason, in 2020 we will inaugurate a combined BA/MA degree. This will allow capable and motivated students to complete their MA in three semesters rather than four, a savings of time and thousands of dollars. We encourage applications from student with strong undergraduate records. The particulars and requirements of the program are as follows:

- 1. Students apply no later than the end of their 6th semester.
- 2. Applicants should have completed at least 18 hours in Anthropology, with at least 9 hours at a 300 level or higher, with a 3.3 GPA in these and any additional Anthropology courses.
- 3. Students first apply to the Department, with the indicated form. If admitted they then submit a separate application to the University Graduate School. http://louisville.edu/graduate/futurestudents/apply-materials
- 4. Upon admission, students will select courses in consultation with their advisor and the DGS.
- 5. Students may apply the same 9 hours of courses at a 500 or 600 level to both their BA and MA degree.
- 6. Admitted students must maintain a minimum 3.0 G.P.A in *all* their coursework during their 7^{th} and 8^{th} semester-equivalent.
- 7. Students may pursue either the thesis or experiential option within the MA program.
- 8. All other requirements for the BA and MA programs remain the same.
