This semester, our group of graduating BFA Students features 7 female and non-binary students who work in a variety of media including sculpture, painting, photography and digital drawing.

For the exhibition, each of our students has created a unique and cohesive body of work that represents their individual artistic practices and theoretical interests. For example, Amaiya Crawford's sculptures revisualize monstrosity and the Other as a means of reclaiming power and agency, while artist Sydney Hughes work explores the relationship we form with digital tools, specifically artificial intelligence, while also observing the visually transformative nature that recent machine learning technologies conjure when interpreting and reproducing a landscape. Artist Raurey Shaw also uses technology in their work to manipulate pre-existing systems to convey frustration about the user experience of operating a human body. Other students participating this semester include Lilly Weakley, Chase Walker, Lauren Sanderfer and Mahika Gupta.

The completion of our BFA student's thesis exhibitions is a testament to their dedication and hard work over the course of their undergraduate careers.
