Deadline: February 15

This form is an application for **all** of the following scholarships:

- The Kenady Lynne Hendershot Memorial Scholarship*
- The Mary Spencer Nay Memorial Scholarship*
- The Hite Scholarship

** Must be graduate of a Kentucky high school to be considered for the Hendershot Scholarship.*

Up to five finalists who do not receive the Kenady Lynne Hendershot or Mary Spencer Nay scholarship will receive Hite Scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$8,000.

** NOTE: All scholarship and award amounts vary depending on tuition rates and student enrollment hours.*

Review and Selection Process

- A minimum **3.0 grade point average** is *required* for applicants to be considered.
- The Department of Art + Design Scholarship Committee will review each application to assess the applicant's:
 - academic standing
 - artistic/academic potential
 - personal goals
 - determination to succeed in achieving his/her objectives.
- If you are selected as a finalist for the Kenady Lynne Hendershot Memorial Scholarship you will be contacted to schedule an in-person interview with the faculty on the University of Louisville campus.
- The recipient of the Kenady Lynne Hendershot Scholarship and the Mary Spencer Nay Scholarship will be chosen from the finalists interviewed.
- Finalists not chosen for the Hendershot or Nay awards will be considered for Hite Scholarships.
- Note: Only those applicants selected for interview will be eligible to receive an award.

Application Checklist

Each applicant must submit the following directly to the Hite Institute of Art + Design at the address below.

- ___ This **Scholarship Application Form** for Incoming Freshman (on reverse).
- ___ An official transcript of all high school work completed.
- ___ Three letters of recommendation from teachers or other school personnel. If you have studied art in high school, one of these letters should come from your art teacher.
- ___ A typed essay (500-600 words) describing your educational and career objectives in the arts.
- ___ Supplemental materials (see below):

Studio Art, Graphic Design or Interior Design

applicants must submit a **digital portfolio** of 10 pieces of completed work.

- Images must be saved in standard JPEG file format (.jpg). Resize to 72 DPI; no greater than 1100 x 800 pixels.
- Do not use PowerPoint, etc. Powerpoint submissions will not be viewed.
- Submit your images on a USB.

Art History applicants must submit a typed essay oriented toward art appreciation or critique, of at least 700 to 1,000 words in length. The essay should reflect not only the student's writing ability, but also the ability to respond visually and analytically to one or more works of art. This is in addition to the above essay describing your educational and career objectives in the arts.
