How to Register for this course:

After discussing your interests with your faculty mentor and arranging a plan for the semester, obtain an independent study form online from the A&S Graduate Education Student Resource page (Independent Study). Once you and the instructor supervising the work agree on your plan of work and the number of credits, sign and have the faculty member supervising also sign (both electronically if possible) and forward to your program director who will process through the department and onto the College for approval. If you miss the online registration window, you will have to obtain signatures and walk the form to the Registrar's Office.

Objectives:

The purpose of this course is to provide credit hours for mentored research experiences. Students will develop effective discipline specific skills and participate in a scholarly community of researchers and learners within the focused research area of the faculty mentor.

Student Learning Outcomes:

- 2. Students will demonstrate professional development and timely completion of assigned and agreed-upon tasks.
