## KEN TERRILL MEMORIAL AWARD 2021-2022

The University of Louisville College of Arts and Sciences announces the 2021-2022 Ken Terrill Memorial Award. The award will be made to help defray the college expenses of a U of L undergraduate student who has demonstrated leadership in or service to the LGBTQ+ community of U of L or the greater Louisville metropolitan area.

Ken Terrill, an Associate Professor of Theatre Arts at the University for seventeen years, was a long-time advocate for gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender students. He was a faculty advisor for the Gay, Lesbian, or Bisexual Alliance (GLOBAL) from its inception until his death in March of 1994. KT's family and friends endowed the award as a lasting tribute to his commitment to students and the LGBTQ+ community.

The minimum award is \$500.

Undergraduate students may apply by submitting a letter (maximum length 3 pages) discussing their leadership and service in the LGBTQ+ community. A copy of an unofficial transcript and two letters of recommendation should accompany the application. One recommendation must come from a member of the faculty or staff of the University. A completed application form should be attached to the student's letter. **Incomplete applications will not be considered**.

Deadline for applications is March 19, 2021. Applications and letters of recommendation should be sent to <u>asawards@louisville.edu</u>.
