The Dr. Milton W. and Ruth I. Roggenkamp Scholarship assists full-time undergraduate students in the College of Arts and Sciences who are approved majors in Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics, or Physics. Preference will be given to students from Crawford, Harrison, or other counties in southern Indiana. Secondary preference will be shown to students from Bullitt, Hardin, Jefferson, Meade, or Oldham counties in Kentucky.

To be eligible for the Roggenkamp Scholarship, a student must:

- 1. Be an approved major in Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics, or Physics.
- 2. Have completed a minimum of one semester at the University of Louisville.
- 3. Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0, cumulative and in the major.

Applicants for the Roggenkamp Scholarship should submit the following to asawards@louisville.edu:

- A completed application form. (Forms may be obtained from the A&S web site (http://louisville.edu/artsandsciences/students/scholarships) NOTE: Students seeking to renew this scholarship only need to provide their name, ID number, contact information, and projected graduation date.
- 2. A 2-3 page personal statement about your career goals and the way in which the Roggenkamp Scholarship would assist you in pursuit of your degree.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation from University of Louisville faculty members, one of which must be from a faculty member in the department of the major.
- 4. A copy of your unofficial transcript.

Previous Roggenkamp Scholarship winners who remain in good academic standing are eligible for automatic scholarship renewal. If you are a previous winner seeking renewal, please complete and submit the top portion of this application ONLY to the Office of the Dean. You are **NOT** required to obtain letters of recommendation.
