THE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES ANNOUNCES THE 2021-2022 ROSEMAN SCHOLARSHIPS

APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 19, 2021

The Wilma Shaw Roseman Scholarships assist full-time undergraduate students in the College of Arts and Sciences who are strongly motivated to complete their degrees and who have substantial financial need. The minimum Roseman Award is \$3,000.

To be eligible for a Roseman Scholarship, students must be full-time undergraduate students matriculated in the College of Arts and Sciences and must have demonstrated financial need as certified by the University of Louisville Office of Financial Aid. A financial aid application for academic year 2021-2022 must be on file with the Office of Financial Aid by March 15. ***Former Roseman Scholarship recipients are eligible to reapply. The scholarship is NOT renewed automatically!***

Applicants for a Roseman Scholarship should submit the following to asawards@louisville.edu:

1. A completed application form, available at <http://louisville.edu/artsandsciences/students/scholarships>
2. A 3-4 page letter discussing your educational and career goals and the way in which a Roseman Scholarship would assist you in pursuit of your degree.
3. Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be from a U of L faculty member.
4. A copy of your unofficial transcript

Awards will be announced in early May.
