Required Immunizations

- Tdap
 - 1 dose within the last 10 years
- MMR
 - Two doses of vaccine OR
 - Positive antibody blood tests
- Hepatitis B
 - 3 Doses of Hepatitis B vaccine OR
 - Positive antibody blood test
- Varicella (Chickenpox) Vaccine
 - 2 doses of vaccine OR
 - Positive antibody blood test OR
 - Physician Documentation of disease
- Quadrivalent Meningococcal Vaccine
 - 1 dose after the age of 16

Additional Suggested immunizations

- Annual Influenza Shot
- Hepatitis A (two dose vaccination series)
