During the workshop, participants will draft an op-ed with the support of the OpEd Project. You will then have a chance to have professional journalists workshop your writing and help guide this op-ed toward publication.

**Workshops will be held on Sept 17 and 18, 3:00-6:30 EST.** Participants must commit to attending both online sessions.

To apply, submit 250 words on the following:

- Your argument and why it is important to share that right now
- Your target audience, why they should care, and what obstacles they may have to your argument
- 2-3 possible publication venues
- Statement committing to attending both online sessions, and submitting your op-ed draft to be workshopped by professional journalists.
