Dorothy Gibson Memorial Fellowship

2022-2023

The 2022-2023 Dorothy Gibson Memorial Fellowship will begin July 1, 2022 and go through June 30, 2023 with no extensions or renewals. It includes a \$23,000 Stipend, Candidacy, and up to \$2,500 to support attendance and presentations at conferences which includes registration and travel.

Eligibility:

Applications are limited to Ph.D. candidates that entered the graduate program in Spring or Fall, 2018 or 2019 who have completed ALL the Ph.D. milestones through the research proposal with a minimum GPA of 3.5 in graduate courses (excluding research) at UofL.

Preparing the Nomination:

The nomination for the fellowship requires the following documents:

- 1. Statement of career aspirations and research plans during fellowship period. Specifically address what activities you will pursue during the fellowship period that will help with your career goals. (1 page only)
- 2. Statement of the broader impacts of your Ph.D. degree and your activities during the fellowship period. Specifically address the potential to benefit society and contribute to the achievement of specific, desired societal outcomes. (1 page only)
- 3. Nomination letter from advisor. The letter must state the advisor has reviewed the applicant's CV and statement of publication contributions and that those items are accurate to the best of the advisor's knowledge. (1 page only) (Note: Advisor(s) can only submit one (1) nomination)
- 4. Unofficial Graduate Transcript
- 5. Curriculum Vita
- 6. Reprint of ALL publications <u>from UofL</u> that are published or in press. Do not included manuscripts in preparation or submitted manuscripts that are accepted with revisions.
- 7. Statement of publication contributions. Specifically address the applicant contributions to the research and to the writing process for publications included in number 6. (1 page only)

Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Nomination Deadline: January 15, 2022

Selection Committee:

Shortlisting of candidates will be made by the Awards Committe and nominations forwarded to the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee is the Department Chair, Department Vice Chair, and Director of Graduate Studies. If there is a conflict of interest, the Department Chair will appoint a replacement committee member.
