Community partnership and engaged service are core elements of the University of Louisville's mission. Whether it is working with students in local public schools, helping to provide services in under-served neighborhoods, or building stronger communities internationally, UofL is committed to collaborating with partners to improve quality of life in places both near and far. UofL Community Engagement projects break down into the following categories*:

127 instances of **ENGAGED SCHOLARSHIP**

Scholarly work done in partnership with the community. It consists of research, teaching, and/or the application of scholarship for the mutual benefit of the institution and community partner.

638 instances of **OUTREACH**

Providing direct services, time, or resources to benefit a community or its institutions. This includes instances of public intellectualism such as talks, lectures, presentations, performances, etc.

260 instances of **PARTNERSHIP**

Ongoing collaboration with community partners for the mutually beneficial exchange of knowledge and resources in a context of partnership and reciprocity.

625 instances of **CURRICULAR ENGAGEMENT**

Describes the teaching, learning, and scholarship that engages students and community partners in mutually beneficial and respectful collaboration.

Student, Faculty, and Staff Engagement

Through the activities taking place with nonprofits, government agencies, philanthropies and industry partners, UofL's faculty, staff and students worked with local, state-wide, national and international communities in engaged teaching, research and service.

Signature Partnership Initiative

UofL's Signature Partnership Initiative, is a University-wide effort to enhance the quality of life, educational and economic opportunity for residents of west Louisville with a goal of working with a wide range of collaborators for community impact.

Projects in KY Counties

The university serves communities across Kentucky in a variety of capacities, through educational collaboratives and the arts, and in providing critically needed healthcare services through the Schools of Medicine, Nursing and Dentistry.

International Service & Scholarship

Students are engaged in experiential learning and service projects in South America, Europe, Africa, and Asia, and faculty work with a range of international research and service partners around the globe.
