Disclosure Guidance (Last revised 03/05/21)

UofL Covered Persons are required to submit an Attestation and Disclosure Form (ADF) at least annually. This document is designed to assist in framing the disclosure topics on the current disclosure form.

Disclosure Category		Disclosure Tip
UofL Section	Relatives Working at UofL	Serving as an instructor, advisor, or lecturer for a student who is an immediate family member, or otherwise evaluate the student's performance, or make a decision concerning an award or reward, or serve on a scholarship committee
	Gifts, Gratuities or Special Favors	Aggregated gifts amounting to greater than \$25 per year from an outside organization that provides good, services, and/or funds to the university or associated organization (ULAA, ULF, ULRF). Examples include: Free meals, discounted items, gift cards, free tickets to entertainment events, software, or other tangible items. Please note that single gift items over \$25 value, must be politely refused
	Sponsored Programs/Projects Administered through UofL	This is for disclosing funding from non-US sources that flows through UofL, as well as, foreign shipping and payments related to these UofL activities.
	Intellectual Property	Includes unlicensed and Intellectual Property not assigned to UofL
US Based Section	Appointments/Affiliations with US entities, external to UofL	Includes not for profit entities and unpaid roles
	Equity/Ownership Holdings and External Financial Interests	Holding any ownership interest (e.g., stock, stock option, or other ownership interest). This includes start-ups. Exemptions are noted.
	External Fiduciary Activity	Includes serving as an agent, board member, broker, director, financial advisor, founder, partner, trustee, etc.
	External Management Activity	Serving in a management and / or operational role (president, officer, director, etc.), regardless of whether compensation is received for a for-profit (public or private) or not-for-profit entity
	External Professional/Research Activity	For disclosing travel paid directly to you by research sponsors, additional paid or unpaid teaching activities, and expert witness testimony (outside UofL role).
	Grants, Contracts, Cooperative agreements, Service Agreements or other funds	Receiving compensation from any public entity and/or the value of any equity interest (excluding purchase of mutual funds) in the entity; Receiving any compensation from any private entity. This includes external consulting activities, serving on advisory boards, and
	Use of UofL Covered Persons or Other University Resources (e.g. equipment, facilities, supplies) in	additional employment related your roles at UofL. This includes assigning or arranging internships, research, assistantships, and/or employment for faculty, staff, or students which you or a relative supervise or
International Section	External Activities Appointments/Affiliations with international entities or governments	evaluate. All foreign appointments and affiliations must be disclosed, even if no compensation is received
	Collaborations (including those anticipated to result in co-authorship)	Report foreign co-authorship occurring within the last three years
	Equity Holdings and External Financial Interests	In addition to stocks, ownership in foreign facilities (storage, manufacturing, etc.) must be disclosed
	External Professional/Research Activity	This includes disclosure of paid and unpaid activities.
	Grants, Contracts, Cooperative agreements, Service Agreements or other funds	Disclose international contracts that rest within UofL, as well as, any contracts outside of UofL
	Gifts	This also includes gifts provided by a third party on behalf of a foreign institution /organization
	In-kind or Donated Resources (Lab or Office Space, Equipment, Personnel, Scientific Supplies)	Use/provision of Lab/Office Space, Equipment, Personnel, Scientific Supplies that is not otherwise paid for by you or UofL
	Scientific Materials not freely available to others Visiting faculty/scholars/scientists/postdocs/students (undergraduate and graduate)	This might be animals, reagents, biological materials, etc. This includes individuals that are compensated by their home institutions or are paying their own way
	Additional International Activities	If you have an international activity that has not been disclosed elsewhere, include the details in this section
