
Instructional Design Support for Summer School Instructors



The Instructional Designers from the Delphi Center have created a plan to support our faculty as they prepare their summer courses.



Overall Plan Details

- 1. Group summer courses into cohorts based on discipline
 - a. Kent/Law
 - b. COB
 - c. CEHD
 - d. Public Health/Dental/Nursing
 - e. A&S Stem/Speed
 - f. A&S Non-Stem/Music
 - g. GA's assigned with their faculty member grouping
- 2. Assign an Instructional Designer (ID) to each cohort- this will be a first line of support for those faculty
- 3. Identify experienced online faculty in each discipline to serve as mentor/support
- 4. Provide access to self-paced online "Basics of Online Teaching" content (will be the aspects of Delphi U that are vital in this situation.) This content is considered the basic content that will get someone thru offering a session this summer. Consider this "Phase 1"
- 5. Each cohort would have a weekly synchronous virtual session focused on course development topics (sessions will be recorded for those that can't attend)

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- 6. Each cohort would have access to "Instructional Design Office Hours" in Collaborate for each cohort to get assistance/support/questions answered
- 7. Faculty can also schedule individual/small group consultations with their assigned ID
- 8. Each cohort will have an asynchronous discussion board to ask questions to each other and the assigned ID
- 9. After Summer is over: Offer a Phase II course with the remainder of the Delphi U content for instructors who want to continue on and complete all the Delphi U content
