All,

Phil Bressoud and I have been charged by Provost Boehm to co-chair a "testing, tracing, and campus health" committee as part of the overall "pivot to fall" initiative led by Provost Boehm. We would like to ask you to be a part of this committee.

While Provost Boehm's overall committee will consider many aspects of academic planning for many different scenarios of physical distancing, hybrid teaching, online teaching, etc., our group will focus on the scheme around testing and tracing that we can/should adopt and the practices on campus that we should require/encourage/suggest. There is work to be done on:

- 1) Designing a testing strategy
- 2) Logistics of how to carry out that strategy
- 3) Data handling
