
## **Embedding Amara Videos**




YouTube makes it easy to caption videos that are in your account, but you cannot add captions to someone else's video. Fortunately, Amara.org allows you to caption videos that belong to someone else. (To learn how to use Amara, see the document *Captioning Videos with Amara*.) This document will show you how to embed a video which has been captioned in Amara into your Blackboard course.




Go to the video's page on Amara.org. Choose **Get Embed Code.** You will see a window similar to this one:







In another browser window, go to the location in your course where you would like the video to appear.

- a. Choose Build Content.
- b. Choose Item.






Enter a title, then click **HTML**.









Copy and paste both sets of text from Amara into the HTML window in Blackboard and click **Update**. The HTML window will close.
