
Providing Extra Test Time in Blackboard



Online Accessibility Series

Overview: A frequent accommodation for students with disabilities is to have extra time on tests and quizzes. Creating custom settings for individual students is a simple setting in Test Options.

1) Create the test and deploy it as usual.




2) On the **Test Options** page, under **Test Availability Exceptions**, click **Add User or Group**.

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



- 3) Choose the student(s) who will have custom settings.
 - a. Click the box next to the name.
 - b. Click **Submit**.



- 4) Under **Timer**, enter the allotted test time in minutes.
- 5) You can set other custom options, such as the number of attempts, auto submission, availability and forced completion.
- 6) Click **Submit** at the bottom of the page.
- 7) All students will access the test the same way and they will all appear in the same Grade Center column for grading. The only difference is that Blackboard will give the student the test with the exceptions you have designated.







- 8) You can go back to add or edit customization any time after the test is deployed.
 - a. Click on the down arrow next to the test name.
 - b. Choose **Edit the Test Options**.
 - c. This will open the **Test Option** page
