

Elementary Education (P-5)

Pre-requisites

Students interested in elementary teacher certification (grades P-5) first complete a bachelor's degree prior to entering the teacher certification program at the graduate level. Students must apply and be accepted into the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) degree program in order to complete teacher certification. Please review the admissions packet of general admission requirements for the MAT program.

All students applying to the Elementary MAT program must complete the prerequisite courses as indicated below to be eligible for application to the program. These prerequisite courses may be taken in post-baccalaureate status.
