## Extension of Secondary (8-12) or World Language (P-12) certification to Middle Grades (5-9) OR adding Middle Grades (5-9) content area

Kentucky certified teachers in Secondary Education (grades 8-12) may extend certification to Middle Grades Education (grades 5-9) through this program. In addition, Kentucky certified Middle Grades Education teachers may add another Middle Grades certification area through this program.

A minimum 2.75 degree grade point average and a current Kentucky teaching license in Secondary Education is required for admission. Candidates apply as graduate, non-degree seeking students.

The program requires specific, undergraduate courses in the selected content area with a minimum 2.50 content grade point average. Please review the links below for a listing of the content courses required:

In addition to the content course requirements, the following Education courses are required:

EDTP/EDAP 541, Middle Level Learner (3 credit hours)

OR Three years middle grades teaching experience

EDAP 511 or EDTP 620, Reading and Writing Across the Curriculum (3 credit hours)

EDTP/EDAP 6XX, Practicum/Field Experience (1-3 credit hours)

Upon successful completion of the required course work and field experiences, candidates must submit a passing score for the appropriate content PRAXIS exam as required by the Kentucky Education Professional Standards Board: <a href="http://www.ets.org/praxis/ky">http://www.ets.org/praxis/ky</a>. In some cases, the Secondary PRAXIS content exam may be used to satisfy the requirement for the Middle Grades PRAXIS content exam.
