GRE (required) and TOEFL (if needed) Examinations

The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) general test is required: Verbal, Quantitative and Writing subscores. The GRE is now administered only on computer at Prometric Testing Centers (see http://etsis4.ets.org/tcenter/cbtdmlst.cfm for Louisville locations).

If you have taken the GRE, have the Educational Testing Service forward scores to UofL (code 1838). If you are a former UofL student and believe your scores are on record at UofL already, attach a note indicating that with your Graduate Application.

The TOEFL Examination is required of foreign students from countries where English is not the native language.

NOTE: All applicants who speak English as their second language MUST pass the TOEFL Examination. The passing score for TOEFL is 213 or higher on the computer-based test.
