- Students notified of acceptance by **February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019**
- Students and teachers submit registration and all accompanying forms by **February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

#### Regional Finalists' Undergraduate Tuition

##### Scholarship Awards:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place receives \$2,000
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place receives \$1,500
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place receives \$1,000

#### National Finalists' Undergraduate Tuition

##### Scholarship Awards (per subject category):

- Each of the 1<sup>st</sup> Place finalists receives \$12,000
- Each of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Place finalists receives \$8,000
- Each of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Place finalists receives \$4,000
