fireworks. Fireworks can be big, and fireworks



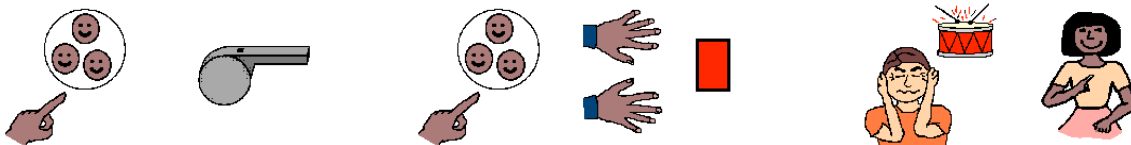
