## **AMS Epsilon Fund Grants for Young Scholars Programs**

**Brief Synopsis from Sponsor:** The AMS Epsilon Fund awards grants in support of summer mathematics programs for mathematically talented high school students. Support will be offered to existing programs that are most successful in nourishing mathematically talented youth. Programs should have been in existence for at least one year, and preferably more. Successful programs tend to have the following characteristics: run over a period of multiple weeks in the summer, bring in at least 20 high school students with mathematical talent, and generally are directed by mathematicians.
