About the award

The **Cardinal Principles Champion** is awarded to **individual** faculty and/or staff who have demonstrated one of the Cardinal Principles at the highest level of excellence and impact.

Nomination period

Nominations are accepted between **December 1 and February 15** each year.

Selection criteria

Recipients of this award should have demonstrated one of the Cardinal Principles at the highest level of excellence and impact.

- Community of care
- Accountability
- Respect
- Diversity and Inclusion
- Integrity and Transparency
- Noble Purpose
- Agility
- Leadership

Nomination guidelines

Nominees must be:

- Employed at the University of Louisville as regular status, full-time staff or faculty.
- Nominations can come from any member of the campus community: co-workers, supervisors, faculty, staff, students, etc.
- Only nomination forms will be forwarded to the University-wide Selection Committee (no additional letters of support will be forwarded).



Award recipients

Award recipients will be determined by a selection committee of university wide UofL engagement ambassadors. Awards will be distributed to eight winners annually, one for each of the Cardinal Principles. Winners will receive:

- Cash award of \$1,000
- Engraved acrylic award
- Feature on Employee Success Center recognition page
- UofL Today recognition
- Recognition at Annual Faculty & Staff Excellence Reception
