The Committee on Academic Performance congratulates the faculty mentors who were the invited guests of our Red and Black Scholar Athletes at the 22nd Annual Red and Black Luncheon and Celebration, held at the KFC Yum Center on Sunday 25 February. 470 student-athletes, managers, trainers, and spirit members were recognized for having earned a 3.25 cumulative grade point average to date.
