REPORT OF THE FACULTY ATHLETIC REPRESENTATIVE

Activities for 2021-2022

The Committee on Academic Performance (CAP), made up of the faculty members of the ULAA Board and chaired by the Faculty Athletics Representative, is charged with oversight of the eligibility and academic performance of our student-athletes. During the 21-22 academic year, the Committee met via hybrid the second Tuesday of each month, August-May.

CAP supports three subcommittees: ULAA Election/CAP Orientation, Student Athlete Well-Being, and Student Athlete Academic Integrity. To support more time for initiatives and discussion in the subcommittees, CAP began a monthly rotation of full meetings and subcommittee meetings and will plan to continue this rotation next year. The committee also had the opportunity to tour the Thornton Academic Center of Excellence.

During full CAP meetings, the following topics were reviewed and discussed:

- -Compliance Annual Rules Education
- -NCAA Academic Performance Rate (APR) and Graduation Rate Reports
- -Administration and Review of End-of -Year Student-Athlete Questionnaires
- -Academic Misconduct Reporting
- -Alston Case
- -NIL
- -One Time Transfer Question and Answer Document
- -Read Only Access

Other activities included the coordination of the election and selection of faculty members to the ULAA Board of Directors in accordance with ULAA Bylaws and Protocols and the administration of the Annual Student Athlete Survey, which gathers information related to missed class time and academic satisfaction of student-athletes.

- Met with teams in the early fall for introductions and reminders
- Met with student athlete regarding results of an academic waiver
- Reported bi-monthly to the Faculty Senate
- Reviewed proposed NCAA legislation with compliance staff and met with compliance staff and the Associate AD for Athletics to monitor various academic and compliance matters
- Mediated faculty/student-athlete concerns
- Received and reviewed daily reports from the Registrar's Office of student-athlete changes of grade and pursued several changes which required scrutiny and clarification
- Reviewed and signed off on ACC Academic Honor Roll

As UofL's FAR, I have represented U of L in pertinent legislative and governance meetings of the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including the attendance of virtual meetings of the ACC FAR Council. I also served as the FAR representative to the ACC Student Athlete Advisory Council.
