

REPORT OF THE FACULTY ATHLETICS REPRESENTATIVE
Faculty Senate
February 5, 2025

The Committee on Academic Performance (CAP) met November 11, 2024. In addition to our standing reports from our subcommittees, academic services, the FAR, Compliance, the Senior Women's Administrator we continued discussions regarding the policies and procedures topics such as NCAA bylaws regarding eligibility and transfer credit.

Each year the NCAA Research Review Board asks the FARs across the country to administer a survey to three randomly selected teams from each university. This year's survey focuses on growth, opportunities, aspirations, and learning of students in college (GOALS). These questions have been designed based on conversations with college presidents, athletics administrators, faculty and national student-athlete representatives who are interested in understanding in detail the issues that students face on campuses. The results of these annual surveys will be used to help craft policies and educational programs that will benefit students and student athletes. At Louisville, Women's Golf, Men's Golf and Men's Soccer were selected to participate in this year's survey.

In addition to my regular activities, I am working with nominated students, faculty and staff regarding this year's nominations for the ACC and NCAA post graduate scholarship application. We look forward to announcing recipients later this Spring.

Did you know? *Sports Wagering and the Super Bowl*

The NCAA has long standing rules prohibiting athletics staff members, including the president, provost, FAR, and student-athletes from engaging in sports wagering activities on collegiate or professional sporting events. Sports wagering activities include, but are not limited to, placing, accepting, or soliciting a bet via bookmaker, sportsbook, parlay card, squares, prop bet (e.g., winner of coin toss, combined score, etc.) in-person, online, or other electronic means.
