NCAA, did you know?

[December's report](#) shared information regarding sport's wagering and betting. As a reminder: Please remember that all Athletic Department staff members and student-athletes are prohibited from wagering on any sport sponsored by the NCAA. This includes internet wagering (e.g., DraftKings, FanDuel, Prize Picks, etc.) entering bracket pools, parlay cards, or placing wagers on any prop bets. In addition to traditional sports wagering outlets, please know these rules apply to predictive markets (i.e. Polymarket, Kalshi, etc.) as well. We understand predictive markets offer commodities other than sports however, it is impermissible to participate in predictive market offerings related to sports sponsored by the NCAA.
