This year, ULARP participated in Homecoming with an inaugural Homecoming Brunch, held at the University Club on October 25, with Women's Basketball Coach Jeff Walz as the keynote speaker. As always, Coach Walz, was very entertaining. A good time was had by all!

ULARP continues to sponsor seminars on wellness and other issues of interest to retirees. The workshop on Polypharmacy, held on October 19, was exceedingly informative. Dr. Demetra Antimisiaris provided multiple examples of ways the drugs we take might interact, and she recommended that all of us pay close attention to medications that might be counterproductive in combination or no longer needed.
