- B. P&BC reviewed 1 new academic degree proposal
 - 1. Proposed On-Line BS in General Studies in A&S
 - a. Proposal documents were received in P&BC on May 18, 2021
 - b. Final P&BC Report was sent to APC on May 25, 2021
 - c. This proposed new undergraduate degree program will be offered entirely on-line, with marketing by the Delphi Center.
 - d. This program will mostly use existing resources (faculty) with addition of new part-time teachers in years 4 and 5.
 - e. There is little if any risk to UofL or to A&S in launching this new BS degree program. In contrast, the potential increase in revenue is excellent, based on potential student interest in a move-at-your-own-pace General Studies program.
