## Report from the FS Planning & Budget Committee (P&BC)

April 6, 2022

- A. P&BC had email discussions & one in-person meeting since the last Faculty Senate meeting.
- B. P&BC reviewed budget aspects of 1 new Certificate and 2 Program Closure proposals.
  - 1. A proposed "6-Sigma Black Belt Certificate" is related to Process Improvement Studies in the Engineering Management program currently offered by the Dept of Industrial Engineering in the Speed School.
    - a. This proposal has a number of budget issues with few details for the proposed budget numbers such that there is inadequate rationale for the proposed budget.
    - b. The student cohort is not clear such that it is not clear that this will be a net revenue positive for the Speed School or UofL.
    - c. P&BC recommended significant revisions of this proposed program to the Academic Program Committee for future reconsideration of this proposal.
    - d. P&BC offered to meet with the Certificate Proposers if they desire.
  - 2. One proposed Program Closure is the <u>Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Art History</u> which is a 121-credit hour undergraduate level degree program in the Department of Art and Design in the College of Arts and Sciences (A&S).
    - a. Justification is low or no enrollment in past years for this program.
    - b. Faculty are currently assigned to other programs and will continue at UofL.
    - c. P&BC assessed that there is no adverse budget effect to this program closure.
  - 3. One proposed Program Closure is a <u>Certificate in Logistics and Distribution</u> which is a graduate program in the Department of Industrial Engineering in the Speed School.
    - a. Justification is low or no enrollment in past years for this program.
    - b. Faculty are currently assigned to other programs and will continue at UofL.
    - c. P&BC assessed that there is no adverse budget effect to this program closure.
- C. P&BC has no proposals currently before the Committee.
