- C. P&BC met yesterday with the organizers of a proposed Center in Positive Leadership in the Business School to discuss and clarify their proposal. P&BC has not yet reached a decision on a recommendation for consideration by the Faculty Senate.
- D. P&BC has no other proposals currently before the Committee.
