Report from the FS Planning & Budget Committee (P&BC)

FS Meeting on November 1, 2023

- A. The P&BC had several remote sessions throughout October to consider multiple proposed degree and certificate programs.
- B. P&BC had extensive Q/A interactions with program proposers regarding the BS degree in Applied Engineering (BS-AE) proposal from the Speed School of Engineering (SSOE). The P&BC completed their review and recommended approval of the budget with reservations about the faculty staffing plan to the APC in October.
- C. P&BC met with the program proposers regarding the BS in Exercise Physiology (BS-EP) proposal from the College of Education and Human Development (CEHD). This proposal is a "rebranding" of a current highly successful "track" which is likely to increase enrollment of students who otherwise would not come to UofL. After clarifications, P&BC found the financial aspects of the proposed program to be appropriate and recommended budget approval to the APC in October.
- D. P&BC completed its review of a BS in Biochemistry (BS-Bioc) proposal from the College of Arts and Sciences (A&S). This is a rebranding of an existing Biochemistry track in the current BS in Chemistry degree program which was recommended by Gray and Associates consulting firm in a 2021 report to the KY CPE. P&BC had no financial budget issues with this proposal and recommended budget plan approval to the APC in October.
- E. P&BC received the Undergraduate Certificate in (DICEEW) proposal from the College of Education and Human Development (CEHD) on September 22, 2023. P&BC Review led to request for more budget detail and justifications, and a P&BC meeting has been scheduled with the program proposers for Friday November 3.
- F. P&BC received the MS in Artificial Intelligence in Medicine (AIM) proposal from the Speed School of Engineering (SSoE) on September 22, 2023. P&BC Review led to request for more budget detail and justifications, but P&BC has not yet received any additional budget material for this proposed program.
