

Members of the Executive Committee and REDBOOK and Bylaws Committees of Faculty Senate are bringing forward a simple REDBOOK change.

In short, the proposal is to increase the Faculty Senate's total voting membership from 70 to 72. This change stems from the *Ad Hoc* Reapportionment Committee's work. As part of developing a simpler and more effective reapportionment process, the new formula requires a slight increase in total membership. The committee has already shared its recommendations with the Executive Committee. Further recommendations for modifications to the Faculty Senate Bylaws will follow.

As part of that process, both the Committee on Committees and Credentials and the Redbook and Bylaws Committee will have the opportunity to review and provide input. This proposed change is intended as a first, minor step to procedurally allow for the broader updates to be considered.
