The Academic Programs Committee (APC) met once in December and once in January (both times with the Senate Planning and Budget Committee). These meetings were to gather information and discuss possible suggested changes to the longtime practice of adding different kinds of tuition-sharing agreements to new program proposals. In these agreements, Deans negotiate specific tuition distribution formulas with the Provost's office. There are approximately 60 such agreements in effect at U of L now.
