The Distilled Spirits Business Certificate proposed by the College of Business (COB) was passed by the full senate at the March 6th monthly meeting.

APC will be meeting with Elizabeth Patton, ESL Program Coordinator from the College of Education and Human Development at 2 pm on April 3, 2019, Wednesday to discuss a graduate certificate proposal of “Teaching English as an International Language (TEIL)”.

The next proposal in the pipeline is MS in Additive Manufacturing and Design from Speed School of Engineering. In addition, COB has another certificate proposal in the works – Business Analytics which is a companion to their recently approved MS. So far APC has not received any of these proposals for review.
