Committee Report for February 3, 2021 Faculty Senate Meeting

The Academic Programs Committee reviewed a proposal from the College of Business for a certificate in the Horse Racing Industry Business. Recommendations were made and the subsequent revision was overwhelmingly passed by the Committee. This proposal was forwarded to the Faculty Senate for the February meeting.

The APC committee elected to withhold consideration of the BA in Computer Science and the Doctorate in Social Work at the January Faculty Senate meeting – as a result of many budgetary and non-budgetary concerns from the P&B Committee. Over the past month, revisions from both Speed School of Engineering and the Kent School of Social Work were provided and overwhelmingly passed by the Committee. These proposals were forwarded to the Faculty Senate for the February meeting.

The APC just received a new proposal from the College of Business for a certificate in Family Business Management and Advising. We will review this with program representatives at our March meeting – with the hope of bringing the proposal to the full Senate at the April meeting.

Due to another appointment, Sarah Frankel (Staff Senate Liaison) has withdrawn from the APC. John Smith (Chair, Staff Senate) will make a new appointment.
