The Academic Programs Committee reviewed two proposals from A&S. The first proposal is an undergraduate ethics program. The second proposal is a graduate certificate in healthcare ethics. We found the utilization of existing resources to accomplish these programs something that could provide a model for other areas on campus. These proposals have been revised and submitted to the full Faculty Senate for their consideration at the May meeting.

In addition, APC has received three program closure proposals – Atmospheric Sciences BS, Instructional Technology MEd, and Literacy Education MEd. The Planning and Budget committee has forwarded on their review regarding the financial impact of these closures and the APC will review and discuss these proposals and come forth to the June Faculty Senate meeting with our recommendations.
